#### About the postponement of the Tokyo 2020 Games

We would first like express, as always, our deep appreciation for your support and cooperation towards the Tokyo 2020 Games. As you've certainly become aware from the wide media coverage, in a teleconference made on 24 March, Japan's Prime Minister Shinzo Abe and IOC's President Thomas Bach reached an agreement over the necessity of postponing the Tokyo 2020 Games to a date no further than the summer of 2021. Soon after the agreement, the decision was officially ratified during an extraordinary meeting of the IOC's board. From now, with the clear policy of holding the event no later than the summer of 2021, we will continue to discuss the details of such postponement with the IOC, IF, and other stakeholders.

We would like to count on your comprehension of the current situation and ask you to consult with the department in charge in the Tokyo 2020 Organising Committee for taking appropriate measures, such as suspending preparatory work, as required.

Once the postponement details have been determined, we will undertake the necessary discussions with all contractors regarding contract changes, such as delivery dates and contract terms, for the ongoing contracts so that we can work together towards achieving the new goals.

We will invest our full efforts into working with the Japanese National Government, the Tokyo Metropolitan Government, the IOC, and all the other Tokyo 2020 Games' stakeholders to achieve these new goals and would like to count on your continuous support and cooperation.
