

Basic Principles of securing environment for Athletes

- Enabling athletes' best performances in a safe and secure environment requires both thorough infection control measures and their smooth preparations including trainings.
- We must devise infection control measures for each setting in the entire process, from athletes' arrival in Japan, throughout the Games and up to the time of their departure. These measures should include not only the care of athletes at competition venues or the Olympic and Paralympic Village and other locations during Games time, but also immigration management, health management (including COVID-19 testing), transport, pre-Games training camps and post-Games friendship programs at Host Towns or other locations, and the establishment of appropriate medical procedures. In addition, we also must create a favorable overall environment and formulate rules from an end-to-end perspective.
