

COVID-19 Testing for Athletes & Other Participants at the Tokyo 2020 Games

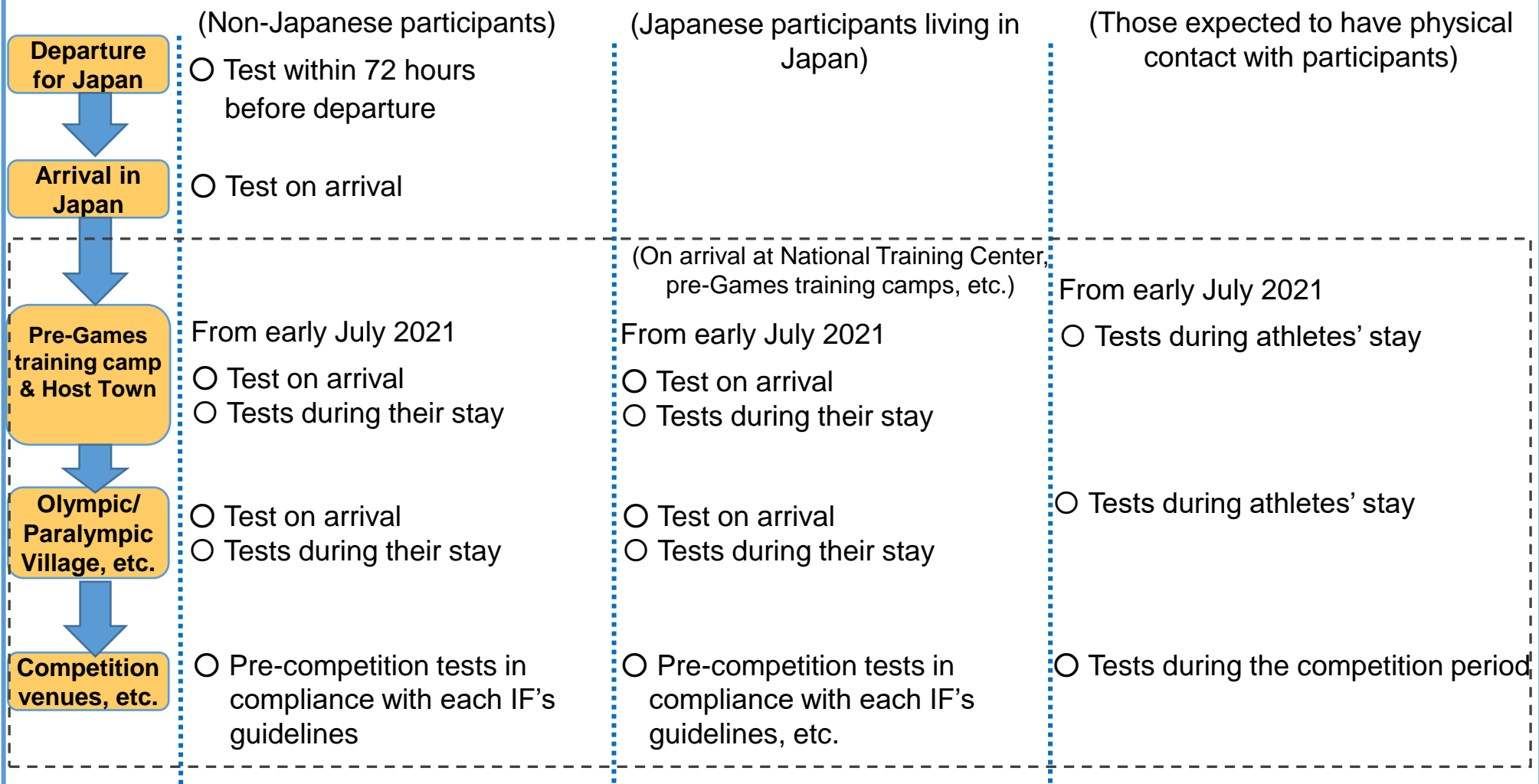
1. Cases needing deliberation

- (1) Non-Japanese athletes and others who will participate in the Tokyo 2020 Games and in other competitions related to the Tokyo 2020 Games (including test events)
- (2) Japanese athletes and others living in Japan who will participate in the Tokyo 2020 Games
- (3) Games stakeholders (IOC, IPC, NOC/NPCs, IFs etc.)
- (4) Those who are expected to come into physical contact with athletes and other participants (including Host Town and pre-Games training camp staff and the Olympic/Paralympic Village workforce)

2. Planned measures (Draft)

Can we discuss and study how testing should be conducted during each phase of the participants' movements as below?

- We will require COVID-19 tests for non-Japanese athletes and other Games participants upon arrival and departure. We will additionally implement all measures necessary for the safe delivery of the Games, including ensuring safe and secure environments at Host Towns and in the Olympic and Paralympic Village.
- Japanese athletes and other Games participants living in Japan will be subject to the same measures as non-Japanese athletes and other participants.
- **Detailed study of measures in cooperation with the IOC, IPC, NOC/NPCs, IFs etc., will be required**



From this point forward we will be examining in detail the way testing should be carried out, such as the frequency of testing at the Olympic and Paralympic Village, pre-competitions, Host Towns and pre-Games training camps. We will also review testing processes and the provision of healthcare and medical support if any athlete or support person tests positive at any time.



Establish processes that allow the rapid obtaining and sharing of test results.
